POLICE REFORM

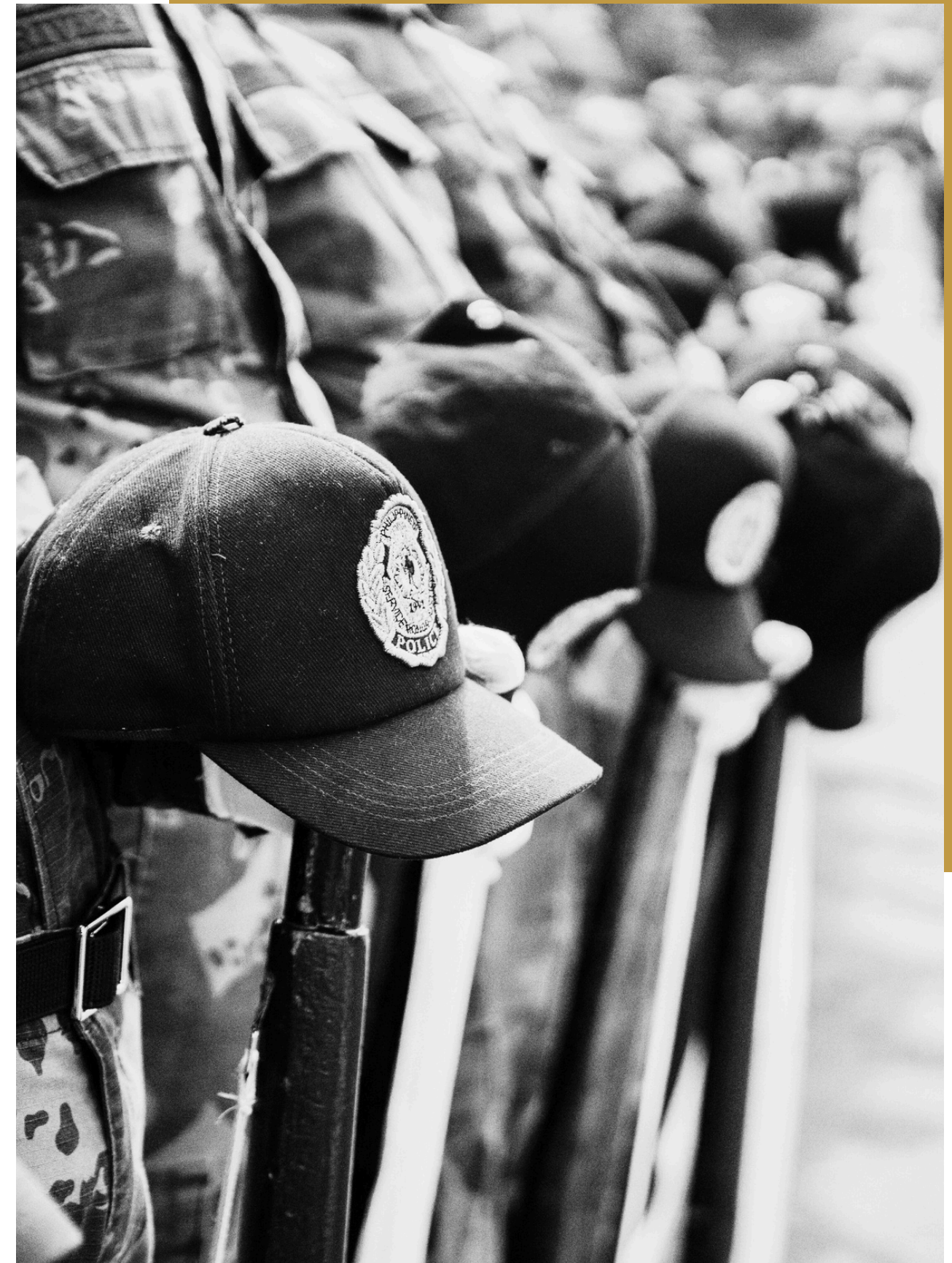
THE ISSUE

Over policing & harsh criminal justice policies that result in **mass incarceration, over-criminalization,** and **racial injustice** in our criminal justice system.

THE RESOLUTION

Equal Justice Now unequivocally says **NO** to defunding the police, and **YES** to police reform. We will dismantle the prison pipeline and preserve the civil rights necessary to prevent injustice at all levels of our criminal justice system.

EJN will raise over **\$100 million** to help Ben Crump's national efforts to fight for victims of police brutality.





VOTER SUPPRESSION

THE ISSUE

Voter rights are **under attack nationwide** as states pass suppression laws.

THE RESOLUTION

A full on assault on any efforts and tactics that **threatens our democracy** and limit the ability of voters to exercise their right to vote.

ENDING SYSTEMATIC RACISM
